- 1. Your internship will occur during the semester in which you are applying for credit. Credit is NOT given to internships that are already finished. Deferred credit is NOT available.
- 2. You will use this internship application ONLY to apply for course credit in Women's, Gender and Sexuality Studies at The Ohio State University. Your internship supervisor might require you to fill out an additional application.
- 3. You will <u>not</u> be added to WGSST 3191 if the addition of those credit hours puts you over the 18 hours maximum load permitted by the university (unless you successfully petition Arts and Sciences to add credit beyond the max of 18.) Please check your course schedule before submitting this application to make certain that adding 1-3 credits will not take you over 18 hours which can result in increased tuition.
- 4. WGSST 3191 is repeatable up to a maximum of 6 hours, and counts as upper division credit in the College of Arts and Sciences. Up to 3 hours from 3191 can count toward the requirements for a WGSS minor or 6 credits for a WGSS major.
- 5. Your internship job responsibilities must be WGSS-related. This course is meant to extend the inclassroom experience of WGSS to the field-based application of WGSS theories and practices.
- 6. You must work the equivalent of the hours specified in this application.
- 7. All hours must be completed by the final day of classes during the AU, SP, or SU term you're enrolled in.
- 8. As a student and representative of The Ohio State University, you are required to abide by the university's Student Code of Conduct (found here <a href="http://studentaffairs.osu.edu/csc/">http://studentaffairs.osu.edu/csc/</a>) during the entirety of your internship. This applies to internships off-campus, as well.
